The Department of Physics of the Naval Postgraduate School, Monterey, California, has an opening for a research associate in the area of Remote Sensing. The Remote Sensing Center needs support in data processing/analysis and administration. The research associate will be required to have a bachelor's degree in Physics, Geography, Geology, Engineering (Computer or Electrical). The person must also have proficiency in office productivity software, proficiency in ENVI, ArcGIS, and have demonstrated team skills and initiative, and excellent written and verbal communication skills.
