Retired Vice Admiral Daniel T. Oliver was commissioned through the Navy ROTC program at the University of Virginia in 1966 and spent his operational career as a Navy P-3 pilot. He culminated his 34 years on active duty as the Chief of Naval Personnel.

After leaving active duty in February 2000, he became engaged in the private sector as a senior executive and board member of a number of companies and civic organizations.

In April 2007, he was appointed as President of NPS by the Secretary of the Navy.
