Master of Science in Contract Management (MSCM)

Department of Defense Management

Commencing 6 July 2023

Distance Learning Program using a Web-based, Virtual Classroom Environment

MSCM is a non-resident, part-time online graduate degree program for qualified active-duty military personnel, federal civilian employees and defense contractors. Students take two courses a quarter for eight consecutive quarters. The program will be delivered over the Internet using a web-based, virtual classroom tool in two 3-hours sessions per week on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 1200-1500 (Pacific Time).

Applicants without previous contracting experience are eligible for admission. This 24-month program supports DAWIA requirements. To use the virtual classroom, students will need a computer with high speed internet access, a microphone/speaker (mandatory) and a web camera (optional). Classes are synchronous with live interaction between the professor and the students, bringing the classes to the students and permitting students to continue supporting the mission of their command/agency. Students are required to be logged on to their classes and participating live.

The price is \$2,600 per course. Eligible active-duty Naval officers are mission funded by the Navy and do not pay tuition. All students who are not active-duty Naval officers must be funded by their sponsoring command/agency. Students are required to purchase textbooks and course materials.
