EVENT DESCRIPTION

Topic Sponsor Synch Session: The Naval Research Working Group 17 (NRWG) kicks off with the Topic Sponsor Sync Session. At this meeting, the Naval Research Program (NRP) staff will give an overview of the week's events, ensuring that sponsors know where they need to be and what they need to accomplish throughout the working group. The primary purpose of the Sync Session is to ensure that sponsors are prepared for a successful week.

NPS Lab Tours: Lab tours are an opportunity for Topic Sponsors to gain a more in depth understanding of the specific research lab capabilities at NPS. Lab tour attendance requires prior registration.

Social and Research Poster Session: Building on information gathered during the lab tours, the social and poster session is primarily an opportunity for our many Topic Sponsors to get a better idea of the breadth and depth of the research taking place at the Naval Postgraduate School. Our world-class faculty study the cutting-edge developments of operational Navies across the globe. Their research extends the reach of today's Naval services, whether underwater, on the surface, in the air, or orbiting the earth. Come see their research projects, ask them to share their expertise, and enjoy the informal social.


Research Tradeshow: During the main event Topic Sponsor Representatives will be assigned a tradeshow booth in the NPS McNitt Ballroom (replaces: plenary session and revolving panels) where they will be able to discuss research opportunities, the benefit(s) to the Services, and expected deliverables from the research. NPS faculty and students are invited to meet with sponsors during the tradeshow to discuss topics and begin scoping research to form an Initial Research Estimate Form (IREF) for topics they wish to research.

In-Progress Reviews (IPRs): Faculty members and students currently conducting research for sponsors who are in attendance during NRWG 17 should coordinate In-progress Reviews in laboratories and other relevant working spaces as they see fit.

Topic Sponsor Outbriefs and Hotwash: Topic Sponsor Outbriefs provide a formal opportunity for Topic Sponsors to give feedback of metric outcomes of the event to the NPS Dean of Research. The Topic Sponsor Hotwash is an informal discussion of the events and suggestions for improvements.

KEYNOTE SPEAKER



Lieutenant General Walsh was commissioned from the Naval Academy in May 1979. After completing The Basic School he was assigned as an infantry platoon commander in 1st 7th Marines. He Battalion, reported to Pensacola, FL and was designated a Naval Aviator in October 1981. Upon completion of an assignment to VT-26 as a Selectively Retained Graduate and the F-4 training svllabus, he was ordered to VMFA-115 at Marine Corps Air Station Beaufort, SC in

November 1983. While in VMFA-115 he transitioned to the F/A-18 Hornet, attended the U.S. Navy Fighter Weapons School, and made two deployments before assuming duties as a flight instructor at TOPGUN in 1987. He returned to MCAS Beaufort in January 1990 and was assigned to VMFA-251, making two WESTPAC deployments, and was selected as the 1st Marine Aircraft Wing Aviator of the Year. In July 1993, he reported to the 9th Marine Regiment as the Air Officer. He attended the Air Command and Staff College at Maxwell AFB before reporting to Headquarters, U.S. European Command, Stuttgart, Germany in 1995 where he served in the Plans and Policy Directorate. In 1998, he returned to MCAS Beaufort where he served as the Commanding Officer of VMFA-115 and deployed to both the European and Western Pacific Theaters. He graduated from the National War College in June 2002 with a Masters of Science in National Security Strategy. From there he served in the Aviation Department of Headquarters, U.S. Marine Corps. After his Branch head tour, Lieutenant General Walsh returned to MCAS Beaufort as the Commanding Officer of Marine Aircraft Group 31 from June 2004 to May 2006. Following command, he served as the Assistant Deputy Commandant for Aviation. In May 2008, Lieutenant General Walsh became the Commanding General of the 2d Marine Aircraft Wing and deployed to Operation Iraqi Freedom 09 as the Commanding General of the 2d Marine Aircraft Wing (Forward). In August 2010 he assumed the duties as the Director of Operations, United States Northern Command. In June 2012 he became the Deputy Commanding General, Marine Corps Combat Development Command. In July 2013, Lieutenant General Walsh assumed duties as Director, Expeditionary Warfare Division for the Chief of Naval Operations. In August 2015, Lieutenant General Walsh assumed his current duties.


